




Venue



1. Disclosure of Conflict of Interest (COI)

• A "Conflict of Interest (COI) Declaration Form" will be distributed at the registration desk. Please fill in the required information and submit the form to the reception desk on the day. The secretariat will keep the submitted forms for three years.

2. Oral presentation

(1) Preparation of your presentation

- Microsoft PowerPoint will be used as the presentation application.
- Presentation data should be sent to the secretariat by e-mail <jagh43west@ams.kobe-u.ac.jp> or <info@jagh43west.net> by noon on Friday 28 February.
- Applications using your own computer will be not accepted. If you have special circumstances, please
 inform the secretariat <u>by Wednesday 26 February</u>.

(2) On the day of the conference

- Please confirm your presentation to make sure that everything is in order on the computer at the reception desk by 1pm. No checks will be accepted after 1pm.
- Please confirm your presentation time and be seated in the "next presenter's seat" at the front of each room 10 minutes before your presentation.
- Each presentation consists of 9 minutes for oral presentation, followed by 5 minutes for Q&A, and 1 minute for changeover, a total of 15 minutes.
- The bell will ring once when 8 minutes have elapsed from the start of your presentation, and twice when 9 minutes. We ask for your cooperation in strictly adhering to the presentation time.

3. Posters

- Panels measuring 150 cm (H) x 90 cm (W) will be available on the 1st floor, on which up to A0 size posters can be accommodated. (up to eight A3 size papers and sixteen A4 size papers can be displayed.)
- The secretariat will provide rivets to attach the panels. Please attach your poster by yourself to the panels with the designated presentation numbers. If you need help, please ask at the reception desk.
- You may attach your poster from 8:00 on the day. Please remove your poster by 18:00. The secretariat will dispose of any leftover posters after the conference.
- Presentation time is during the lunch break (12:10-13:30). There will be no designated time for each presentation, and no chairpersons/ moderators will be assigned.
- A time for questions and answers from participants will be posted in or next to your poster by yourself, and please wait at the poster location during this time.
